Items contained herein are:

Three Ring Folder Covers with Clan MacTavish Crest and information.

1. PDF documents that contain both text and images relative to the history of Clan MacTavish. These may be printed in actual size and displayed inside of Clear Document Holders (3 rings sets) within 3-ring folders or in large display frames or both.
2. JPEG IMAGE FILES – self explanatory. These may be printed and displayed.
3. JPEG, BITMAP or MS WORD images that need to be enlarged and laminated. These may be printed via a computer printer, then photo enlarged and laminated for display. Quality of these items will allow printing on 8 by 11 inch paper and enlargement to 11 by 17 inch paper (laminated) with good readability and quality.
