Dal Riata may have been annexed, temporarily, some Pictish lands in the wake of those campaigns, and Aedan's son Eochaid is called king of the Picts by the Annals of Ulster on his death in 629. The following year died Eochaid's son Dicuill, who in the Annals of Tigernach is called king of Cruitheniath, that is, the kingdom of the Picts.
